PRAYER OF PRAISE*

ADVENT

Dates of the Season: Advent is the four weeks, including the four Sundays, before Christmas Day.

Colors for the Season: The color is purple, which symbolizes both penitence and royalty (sometimes blue).

SCRIPTURE - Isaiah 40:3-5

HYMN "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus," v. 2 82 Born thy people to deliver, born a child and yet a king, Born to reign in us forever, now thy gracious kingdom bring. By thine own eternal Spirit rule in all our hearts alone; By thine all sufficient merit raise us to thy glorious throne.

CHRISTMAS

Dates of the Season: Christmas Season begins with Christmas Eve or Christmas Day and continues through the Day of Epiphany, January 6.

Colors for the Season: White and gold

SCRIPTURE - Luke 2:1-7

TIME WITH CHILDREN

EPIPHANY

Celebration of Epiphany: If January 6 falls on a weekday, churches may celebrate Epiphany on the Sunday before or after. *Colors for Epiphany:* White and gold.

LENT

Days of Lent: Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on the Saturday before Easter. Lent lasts forty days, not counting Sundays. Sundays aren't counted because Sunday always celebrates Jesus' victory over sin and death.

The Color for Lent: Purple, a royal color that also signifies penitence and preparation.

SCRIPTURE - Matthew 16:21-23

GOOD FRIDAY

The Date of Good Friday: Good Friday is the Friday before Easter. Colors for Good Friday: The worship space is either void of decoration and color, or black is used.

CONFESSION OF SIN (UNISON)

Sovereign God, we are not ready for your holy kingdom. You guide us toward right paths, but we

refuse to follow where you lead. You love and feed and care for us, but we fail to love and serve others. Forgive us, merciful God, and restore us, so that we may return to your fold and rejoice in your presence, for the sake of the Lamb upon the throne.

EASTER

Date of Easter: Easter Sunday is the first Sunday after the full moon that occurs on or next after March 21, the spring equinox. Easter can be any time from March 22 through April 25. The date may differ in Orthodox Churches. The Easter season lasts until Pentecost, and is sometimes called "The Great Fifty Days."

Colors for the Easter Season: White and gold

SCRIPTURE – Luke 24:1-9

HYMN "Jesus Christ is Risen Today," v. 1

Jesus Christ is risen today, Alleluia! Our triumphant holy day, Alleluia! Who did once upon the cross, Alleluia! Suffer to redeem our loss. Alleluia!

PENTECOST

Date of Pentecost: The fiftieth day after Easter. Colors for Pentecost: Red or red on white. Red, the color of fire, represents the Holy Spirit.

HYMN "On Pentecost They Gathered," v, 1 289
On Pentecost they gathered quite early in the day,
A band of Christ's disciples, to worship, sing, and pray.
A mighty wind came blowing, filled all the swirling air,
And tongues of fire a-glowing inspired each person there.

SEASON OF PENTECOST/ORDINARY TIME

Dates of the Season: From the day after Pentecost through the Saturday before the first Sunday in Advent. Some Sundays following Epiphany and before Lent are considered Ordinary Time. Colors for the Season: The basic color is green, symbolizing growth in Christ. White is used on Trinity Sunday, All Saints Day, and Christ the King Sunday.
